In December Ashford Green Party campaigners, Maria Pizzey and Thom Pizzey supported health activists by attending the judicial review of the stroke service consultation at the Royal Courts of Justice. Thom Pizzey said, "No hospital could alone be expected to cope with the demand of the entire East Kent population and increased travel distances poses a life-threatening danger to stroke patients. We will continue to call for stroke units to stay open not only in Ashford but across Kent."
